The applicant agrees as follows:

(1) Time of Project. Work will commence on or about _____ and will require _____ days.

(2) Digging or Excavating in Road. Digging or Excavating in Road will not be permitted unless no reasonable alternative method is available. If the proposed installation requires digging in the road, give the following information:

a.) Conditions necessitating digging or excavating in road _____

b.) The excavating to be made in the road will be _____ feet long by _____ feet wide and _____ feet deep.

c.) Pavement is to be replaced by: _____

as directed by and to the complete satisfaction of the Pike County Engineer. The applicant will backfill as directed by the Pike County Engineer in accordance with Section 603.08 of the "Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications."

(3) Digging or excavating along road:

a.) With minor exceptions, the proposed utility shall be placed within the confines of the public right-of-way at a minimum depth of 1.5 feet and a minimum distance of 4.0 feet from the edge of the paved road surface.

b.) When the proposed utility is placed in, or crosses existing road ditches, the minimum depth shall be 3.0 feet.

c.) Because drainage structures (such as culverts) are periodically excavated and replaced, the proposed utility shall be placed around or under such structures. Specifically, damage to utilities placed over drainage structures is the responsibility of the utility.

d.) Damage to drainage structures is the responsibility of the utility, as is damage to the road pavement and shoulder. If repairs are not made within 10 days by the utility, repairs will be made by the County Engineer and costs billed to the utility.

(4) Driveways and Access approaches. Applicant will construct and maintain driveways or access approaches to the satisfaction of the Pike County Engineer in accordance with the completed attached drawing.

(5) Maintenance of Traffic. Traffic will be maintained at all times unless written permission is granted by the Pike County Engineer to close the road. All work requiring men or vehicles on the pavement or shoulders will comply with all the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices of the Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Material Specifications and any guidelines issued by the Pike County Engineer. Failure to comply with this requirement will be cause for immediate suspension of the permit until the proper traffic controls have been provided.

(6) Restoration of Pavement, Berm Slopes, Guardrail, and Drainage Structures. The applicant will be responsible for the replacement of the pavement, berm slopes, and guardrail to their original condition. Any drainage structure will be replaced or repaired to its original condition and any drainage problem arising from this work will be the responsibility of the applicant hereafter.
